Eden to find their salvation. It is run by a genuine queen of stewardship, her staff and kind volunteers. On this vast farm there are neighborhoods for each species, while some lucky healthy dogs, cats and even fowl are allowed to run free. As you stroll about the property a gregarious sans tail Havana named Taco will be your guide as he lives up to his reputation as the knave of hearts. If you are more



of a dog person, the huge white dogs Beauty and KiKi will do their part to win you over.

Watch out for the goats, who all look perpetually pregnant thanks in part to a great diet and their not so fussy palate as they nudge you to feed them and scratch between their horns. During your tour among the delighted residents the explanation for their contentment is found in the exquisite medical care and daily upkeep for special need animals as well as the general population.

The inhabitants of Rikki's Refuge rely on donations from the public to keep their home running smoothly. Cost of medicine alone is astronomical and there are so many in need of extra veterinary assistance. Vincent is a prime example as a hit and run survivor who required surgery and now constant maintenance of other physical issues which stemmed from the initial trauma. There are the chronically ill with leukemia, FIV, diabetes, heart disease and cancers, whose needs are not cheap either, but in order to give them the quality life they deserve and receive must be met. These babies who would have received the needle if not for Rikki's Refuge get to live out their remaining days in a happy, clean environment where the humans tend to them with unconditional love

Right now there is a financial crisis at this idealistic farm. Criminals took credit cards, tapped into bank accounts and stole mail box keys to get access to money sent via post. Local law enforcement and the post office are working towards exacting justice. This means that all the funding used to look after the animals is lost or frozen. Grounds keeping, administration of medicine and daily care are being forcibly stretched thin due to this selfish act of robbery.
